the Museum of Modernity, presenting technological advancements which were developed in Obstyn throughout the years for breweires, cinemas and a match-making factory. It's also a landmark because of the 25-metre factory chimney, easily seen from afar. It's not the original one from the sawnill, because that one was demolished long ago. A dummy was supposed to replace it, but it was considered easier to borrow, translocate and install an entire chimney from a brickworks in a village nearby. So that's what happened. At the Park's grounds you find a relic of the old industrial area. It's a 1884 sawmill. Nowadays it houses


